

Overview	<i>The Australian Open, Grand Slam of Asia-Pacific, is one of the largest and most prestigious sporting events in the world. Book your place to be there in January 2014 with the Junior Australian Open Asia Pacific Wildcard Playoff (JAWP) taking place in Shenzhen, P.R. China. Main Draw Wildcards are on offer for Asia-Pacific's winning Junior Singles tennis players.</i>		
Eligibility	The JAWP is open to all Nationals from the Asia Pacific region, aged 18 and Under as per the ITF rule book definition (born on or after 1 January 1996 and before 31 December 2001), excluding Australian's, with a ITF Junior World Ranking of 101 or higher for Boys and 101 or higher for Girls (based on Junior AO cut off for Boys of 100 and Girls of 100) at the time of the entry closing. <i>If anyone is ranked lower than these stipulated rankings and are concerned about any points they need to defend, you may contact the Tournament Referee for special dispensation to play.</i>

A letter of invitation from the tournament is required and requests should be sent to Lu Liang who will assist in the processing. Contact details are provided below.
