

Overview	<p>The Australian Open, Grand Slam of Asia-Pacific, is one of the largest and most prestigious sporting events in the world. Book your place to be in Melbourne in January 2017 with the Australian Open Asia-Pacific Wildcard Play-off (AWP) taking place in Zhuhai, China. Main Draw Wildcards are on offer for Asia-Pacific's winning Singles and Doubles tennis players.</p>	
Eligibility	<p>The JAWP is open to all Nationals from the Asia Pacific region, aged 18 and Under as per the ITF rule book definition (born on or after 1st January 1999 and 18th January 2004), excluding Australians, with a ITF Junior World Ranking of 101+ for Boys and 101+ for Girls (based on the Junior AO cut-off for Boys of 100 and Girls of 100) at the time of the entry closing. Players with a World Ranking of 1-100 for Boys and 1-100 for Girls may also apply for entry if they are concerned about any points they need to defend. They will need to contact the Tournament Referee for a special exemption to play. Players may also enter AWP Doubles. To be eligible to participate players must have at least one ITF/ ATP/ WTA Tour rankings point in singles or doubles.</p>

The nearest mainland airport is Zhuhai Airport located 60 minutes by taxi to the venue and hotel. Macau International Airport (MFM) is located 29-30km to the venue and hotel. Hong Kong International Airport (HKG) has a ferry to Zhuhai Jiuzhou Port (approximately 25 minutes by cab to the venue and hotel). The ferry is approximately \$340 HKD / 290 RMB (\$30-\$40 USD) and taxi fare from port to venue and hotel is approximately 40-60RMB (\$6-\$8 USD).

<p>** VISAS **</p>	<p>All players require a visa and should contact the CTA (China Tennis Association) and Chinese consulate for information. A letter of invitation is required from Mr Lu Liang (CTA) and requests should be sent to Zuo Lingyuan (Sophie) (contact details below).
