Dear member of the Federation,

PURPOSES & BASICS:

For the first time in the history, the prestigious Les Petits As - Le Mondial Lacoste (14 & Under) organizes a qualifying event for the Asian continent. **The Asia Playoffs from 15th to 21st (until 19th + 2 days in case of heavy rain) of October 2018.** The event takes place in the **Club Med Resort of Bali, Indonesia.**

The purpose of our Playoffs is to select the best non-europeans players on-court. All the Asian players will be selected only through the qualifying Asia Playoffs. Please notice that no wild cards will be delivered for Asian players who will not take part in the Asia Playoffs.

WILD CARDS & RULES:

6 boys and 6 girls will be qualified for the biggest world tournament 14 & Under in January 2019 in Tarbes, France: Les Petits As - Le Mondial Lacoste.

The players who will participate to the Asia Playoffs should be still eligible for the category 14 & Under in January 2019 - **only players born in 2005 or after will be accepted on the Asia Playoffs.**

ENTRY LIST & REGISTRATION:

We are glad to announce that we have opened the candidatures for your country. You may send us an official list of the players you would like to register to the event. **The official list allows six boys and six girls for each federation, classified by order of priority.**

The tournament council will **select the players regarding their profile and ATF ranking.** Each federation who takes part in the Asia Playoffs is **assured to have at least one player in the main draw (each country might get a maximum of 4 boys and 4 girls - total 8 players).**

The format of the competition is a **draw of 32 players with a group phase** (Round-Robin). Each player will play at least 2 matches in the competition.
