VISA INFORMATION FOR THE 2022 AUSTRALIAN OPEN JUNIORS

All persons attending **AO2022** will require an Australian visa.

Listed below are the current visa options available to participants of the 2022 Australian Junior Tennis Championships

Please read through the below information to ensure that you apply for the appropriate visa type according to your role or the activities to be undertaken at the event. Any participants found to be holding an incorrect visa may be refused entry to Australia, have their visa cancelled, or may not be permitted to participate at the event.
